## The Prior Cycle 2020-2021 **Before March Deadline** (and COVID) **Opened October 2019**



## 2020-21 Cycle: FAFSA, Before March Deadline, HS Seniors Only

## **HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR CLASS OF 2020:**

• March, 2019 completed apps by HS Seniors: 252,110

March, 2020 completed apps by HS Seniors: 260,045

+7,935 apps, or +3.14 %

• CA was one of only two states nationally that had an increase in <u>HS</u> Senior FAFSA apps in 2020 (US down 2%)



## 2020-21 Cycle: FAFSA, Before March Deadline, All Submissions

#### **ALL FAFSA SUBMISSIONS:**

• March, 2019 completed apps: 1,712,952

• March, 2020 completed apps: 1,610,572

-102,380, or -6.0%


• CADAA apps were down -1.8% at March deadline (35,909 vs. 35,255)




## FIRST-TIME STUDENTS

#### **FAFSA 2020-21 CYCLE: FINDINGS**

HS grad class was robust prior to March deadline and COVID

#### After March deadline and COVID:

- Decline in first-time freshmen; increase in advanced undergrad and grad students
- Decline in lower-income zip codes
- Decline in high % Black/Hispanic areas
- Decline in males
- Decline, then rebound in higher-income zip codes

#### **FAFSA 2021-22 CYCLE: EARLY RESULTS**

New and Renewal FAFSA/CADAA filed as of November 23:

<u>Year</u>	FAFSA	CADAA
11/21/2020	629,285	6,745
11/22/2019	590,490	8,882

FAFSA: +6.6% CADAA: -24.1%



#### **HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS: 2021-22 FAFSA SUBMISSIONS**


