Purpose of SEARS

- CSAC has a statutory mandate to "Collect and disseminate information concerning the financial resources and needs of students..." [Education Code sec. 69514(b)].
- Establish CSAC's Student Expense Budget (SEB)
- Develop report on student experiences paying for college
- Provide campus-level data to participating institutions



Timeline – Completed Items

- Meet with segmental representatives (SEARS Advisory Committee)
- Reach out to student representatives for input on survey
- Invite private institutions to participate
- Send MOUs to participating segments and institutions



Timeline – In Progress

- Submit project application to state IRB for human subjects approval
- Execute MOUs with participating segments and institutions
- Administer survey online to four-year students in fall 2021 and to community college students in spring 2022
- Analyze data and publish student expense budget, return data



Changes to Survey

- Removed questions
 - Food and housing insecurity
 - Credit card balance
 - Marital status
 - Non-financial obstacles to success in college

- Added questions
 - Internet access points
 - Zip code and commute time
 - Commuting costs to permanent residence
 - Car payments



Changes to Survey

- Edited questions
 - Separated child from non-child dependents
 - Changed hours and wages to close-ended responses
 - Separated Internet costs from housing and utilities
 - Wording changes for clarity

- Administration
 - Surveying at all CCCs
 - Surveying at least 25% of all undergraduate students at each institutions
 - Emailing survey through Mailchimp
