Process and offer New Competitive Awards

- ✓ Consolidate March 2nd and September 2nd Competitive cycles into one Competitive Cycle
- ✓ Decrease paid recipients from 41,000 to 13,000
 - ✓ Offered: 51,000 to 16,000
- Remove applicants attending community college
- ✓ Status: Completed on Friday, September 10, 2021

Process and offer New CCC Entitlement Awards (part 1)

- ✓ Create new awarding program in Grant Delivery System
- ✓ Include all potential CCC applicants including
 - Competitive students (awarded & not awarded based on score)
- ✓ Status: Completed on 11/15/2021
- √ 139,902 total initial award offers
- ✓ Net new awards= 100,000 new awards
- ✓ Will make new awards every week



IN PROGRESS

Process and offer New CCC Entitlement Awards (part 2)

- ✓ Include school change and award portability logic
 - School change to UC or CSU retain award
 - School change to non-UC or CSU reevaluate for other Cal Grant
- ✓ Status: In development and schedule is TBD



IN PROGRESS

Increase Access Award for Foster Youth

- Create new program in Grant Delivery System
- ✓ Cal Grant A and B \$6,000 new and renewals.
- ✓ Cal Grant C \$4,000 for new and renewals
- ✓ Status: In development and schedule is TBD



IN PROGRESS

Process and offer updated Cal Grant C Award

- ✓ Not in budget changes, but applicant pool dramatically decreased due to:
 - ✓ CCC students not eligible for Cal Grant A & B in former competitive cycle and could have been Cal Grant C, now eligible in CCC entitlement award program
- Update Cal Grant C program in Grant Delivery System
- ✓ Status: In development and schedule is TBD

Dreamer Service Incentive Grant (DSIG)

- Encourages California Dream Act Applicants (CADAA) with a Cal Grant B award to perform community or volunteer service.
- Awards up to \$3,000 per academic year (up to \$1,500 per semester or up to \$1,000 per quarter) to 2,500 eligible students.
- Students shall perform at least 150 hours per semester or 100 hours per quarter of community or volunteer service with a qualifying community or volunteer service organization.



Dreamer Service Incentive Grant (DSIG)

- Eligible students must apply annually and complete community or volunteer service hours in that academic year.
- Grant will be available to the student for up to 8 semesters or up to 12 quarters while they have an active Cal Grant B award.



Dreamer Service Incentive Grant (DSIG)

- Applications Received: 139
- Applications Accepted: 79
 - UC Applications: 4
 - CSU Applications: 45
 - CCC Applications: 30
 - Private Segment Applications: 0
- Payment Requests: 5 (to be processed)
- 2021-22 DSIG program opened on July 1, 2021 and will continue through June 30, 2022



Golden State Teacher Grant Program

- July 1, 2021 Online Applications open 2021-22 award year
 - Added new eligibility to online application including kinder teach preparation, teacher internship and residency programs
- November 2021 Institutional and LEA users given access to new GST WebGrants screens
 - Certification of applicants
 - Applicants will sign Teaching Agreements in WebGrants
- **December 2021** First payments sent to applicants
