PCS Responsibilities

The PCS is responsible for:

- Effective oversight of State financial aid programs.
- Evaluating compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
- Assessing controls around the administration of the programs.
- Recommending corrective actions.

Audit Selection Criteria

Risk Assessment, prior audit results, date of last review, at-risk program

Fieldwork

 Request for documentation, entrance meeting, fieldwork, audit review, reporting

Common Areas of Noncompliance

Applicant Eligibility, Fund Disbursement, Fiscal Responsibility, General Eligibility

Audit Closure Process

Findings, at-risk program, policies and procedures, audit report



Process Improvements

- 100% paperless audits
- Automation of testing workpapers
- Time savings
- Cost savings
- Legislative reports

Current Year Audits and Future Plans

- 12 audits performed and closed in fiscal year 2020-21.
- Restrictions due to pandemic delayed audits that were planned.
 - Audit team reassigned to contact tracing assignment
 - Audits stopped due to stay-at-home order
- Downtime utilized to implement the above improvements.
- FY 2021-22 Plans:
 - 43 audits planned for the year.
 - Remote audits due to COVID-19 travel restrictions.
 - Continue streamlining the audit process and programs.
