


# FAFSA & CADAA Submission Trend Summary

- Overall FAFSA/CADAA applications are down year over year with declines among overall undergraduates and first-time entering students
- Dream Act applications are down year over year
- By segment, overall applications are down at private-independent colleges, California Community Colleges & the CSU system but are up at UC
- By student characteristics application declines are most pronounced for ages 20-29 and those with an EFC <\$5k</li>


### **Race to Submit Summary**

- Submitted and completed FAFSA/Dream Act Applications among high school seniors is down compared to last year
- Cal Grant applications & awards are also down among seniors since last year



## Fraudulent Applications @ CCC

- Fraudulent FAFSA submissions for first-time, >30 age, Pell-eligible CCC "students" began April 2021
- Fraudulent activity (and subsequent applications and enrollments in CCC) occurred primarily in Fall of 2021
- Activity seemingly ceased around early December, 2021 and is not showing up since then.
- Total estimated bogus FAFSA's filed:
   ~80k
