FAFSA & CADAA Submission Trend Summary

- Overall total FAFSA & Dream Act applications continue to be down year over year
- By segment, overall applications are down at California Community Colleges, CSU and private-independent colleges but are up at UC
- By student characteristics application declines are most pronounced for aged 20-29 and those with an EFC in the 0-5k range
- Applications are up among first-time entering students. By segment first-time applications are up at each of the public segments (CCC, CSU & UC)
