Statewide student leadership presentation

SUMMARY:

Student leaders from the three statewide student associations representing public higher education students will introduce themselves to the Commission and discuss their organization's priorities for the year.

RECOMMENDATION:

This is an information item; no action is required.

BACKGROUND:

Students at each of California's public segments of higher education are represented by an officially chartered statewide student association. A panel of leaders from the three statewide associations representing students at each of the public higher education will present on their organization's priorities for the upcoming year:

- Chanelle Win, Vice President of Legislative Affairs, Student Senate for California Community Colleges
- Dominic Quan Treseler, President, California State Student Association
- Celene Aridin, President, University of California Student Association

Additionally, the Association of Independent California Colleges and Universities (AICCU) hosts the Independent California Colleges Advocate Program (ICCAP), a competitive, six-month program attended by a cohort of diverse students from the AICCU member institutions. While the ICCAP represents over 380,000 undergraduate and graduate students, a student speaker will not be able to present due to changes in the ICCAP cohort and timing of institutions returning to campus.

Each student leader will introduce themselves and discuss their organization's priorities for the year, with a particular focus toward any issues involving college affordability or other Commission priorities.
