5. (Item 11) Update on Competitive Cal Grant Program (Information)

Catalina Mistler, Deputy Director of the Program Administration and Services Division, Alessandra Morrison, Assistant Deputy Director of Institution and Support Services, and Lisa Wright, Manager of Institution and Support Services, were invited to present on the Competitive Cal Grant Program.

Ms. Mistler provided a background overview of the Competitive Cal Grant Program and the eligibility requirements that students must meet to compete for a Competitive Cal Grant award.

Ms. Morrison explained the difference in numbers between financially eligible applicants and limited awards offered. She also highlighted the paid rate for the current and prior years.

Ms. Morrison proceeded to the new eligibility for CADAA applicants to participate in the Competitive Cal Grant program.
